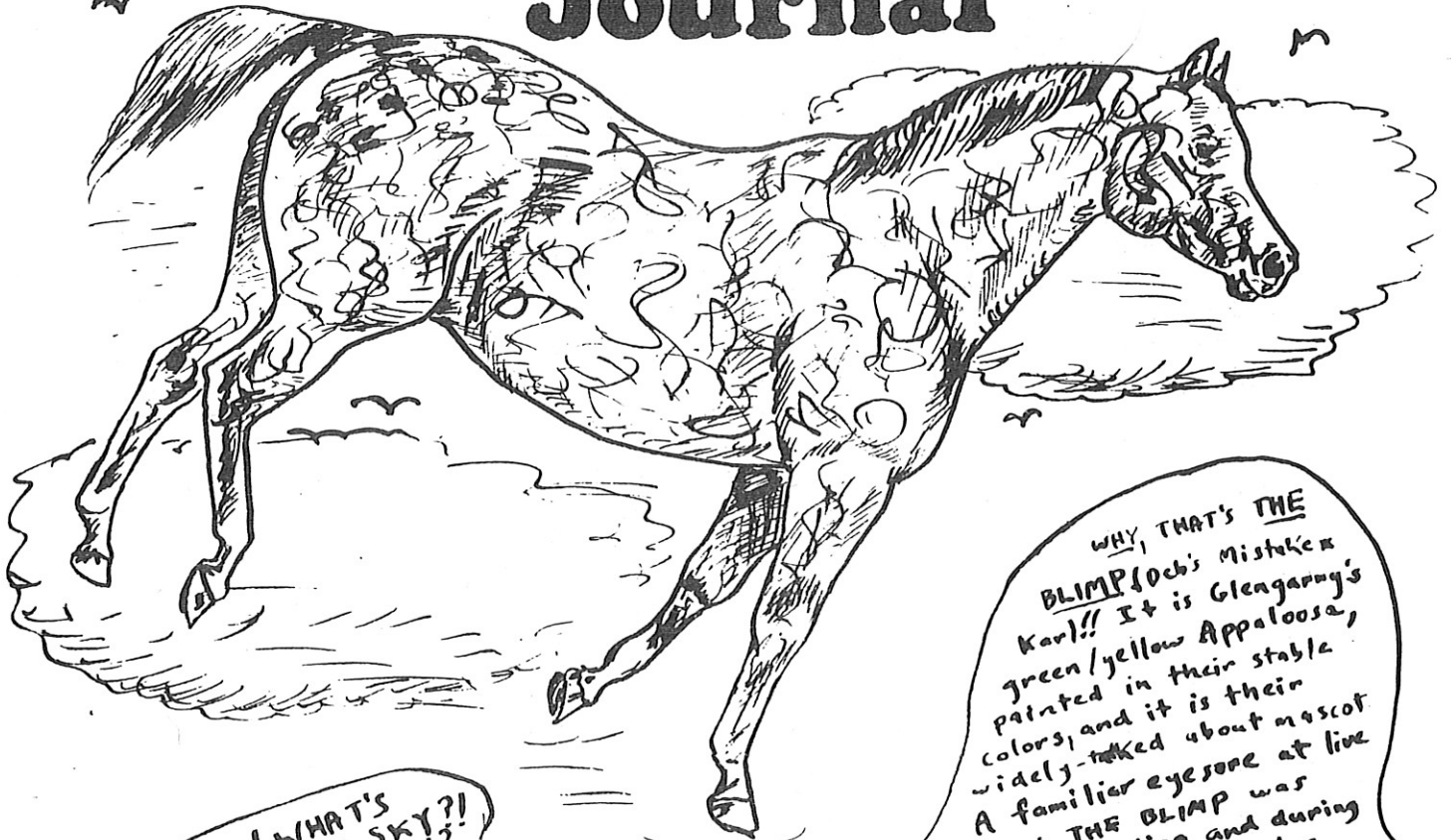
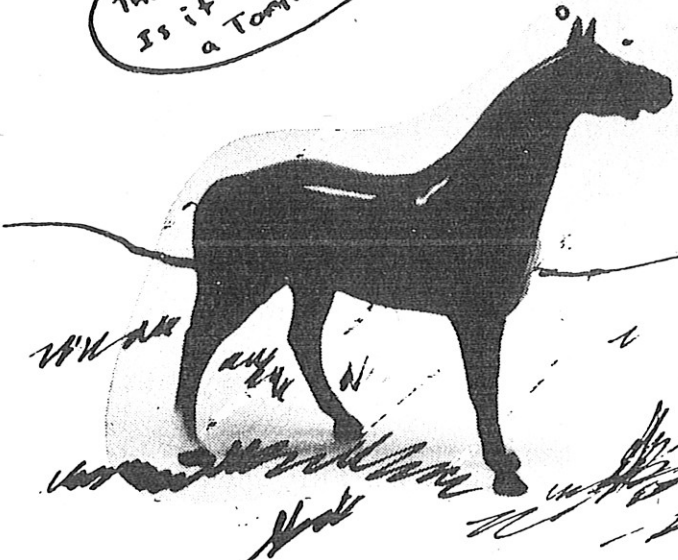


# The Model Horse Shower's Journal

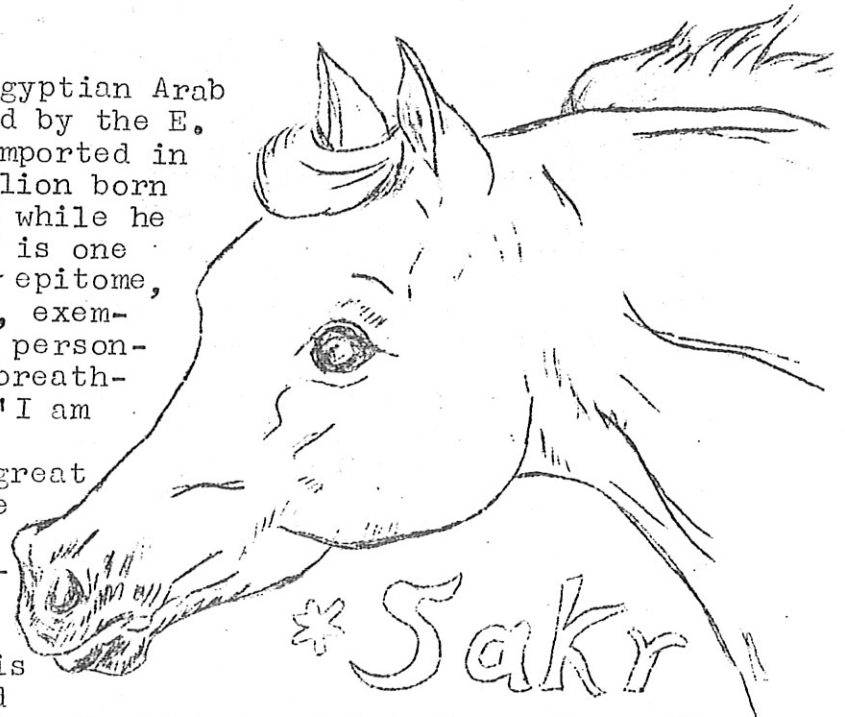

He's a Beswick Arab in rich bay. He's also sired a lovely H-R mare repainted black w/3 socks & stripe named \*Leprechaun. \*Leprechaun is a lovely little mare who won a Champ Jr. Mare at her 1st show w/a super crummy pic. 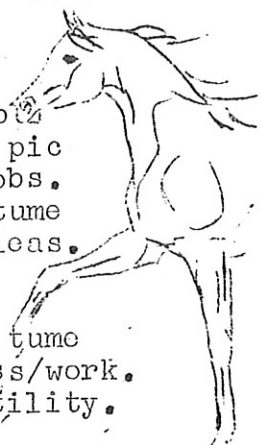
