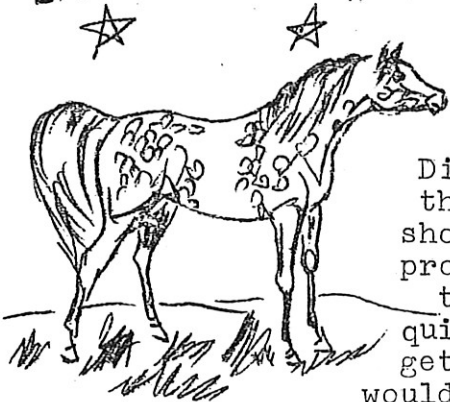

She's shown as a Welsh Pony mare & does very well: 1st-9, 2nd-6, 3rd-4, 3 Res. Champs... CEDAR PARK SANDPIPER (Starlights Falcon--a real Welsh stal. owned by Sherry Cook x Pickwick's Sand Pebbles) is the 7" Morgan stal. w/added dark points & blk. hair m/t, making him a golden dun. He is one of her favorites & is shown as a Welsh Pony stal. He has many won many Champs plus 1st-20, 2nd-13, 3rd-12, etc. He's versatile, showing in WP, EP, saddleseat, huntseat, harness & halter. Soon he'll debut in Trail & perhaps costume... That was great, terrific & fabulous & we'll finish her article in Dec. Now for a surprise! A little info on Leftons for a few of those UFO's that might be Leftion, plus info for the curious about them. Leftons are from Japan & cost from \$1.29 on up to \$5 or more. 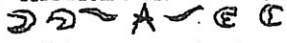

Thank you, Veronica, so much for writing in! I'm sure every reader enjoyed the history of these TB's/antiques. Until next month, happy antique hunting!!

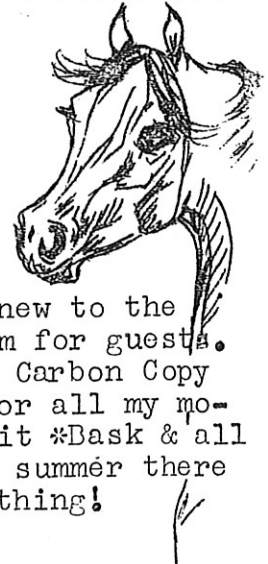

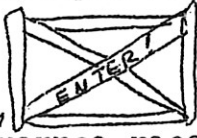

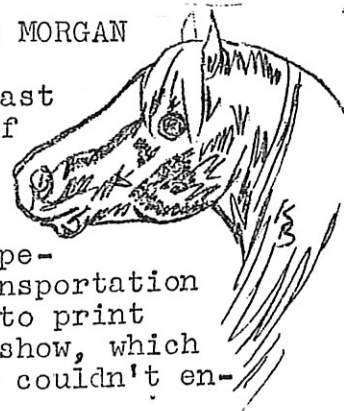
