"Why do so many judges favor 35mm pix? In many shows only 35mm pix seem to place & many times the quality of these horses is inferior to others! I always look at the HORSE & NOT the pix as if it were a real horse show. Conformation comes BEFORE photography! I never count the photo for or against a horse when judging. Yes, there are MANY horses w/35mm pix that are great, but judges, PLEASE look at the HORSE! Also many judges favor repaints, even if the conformation is bad. Why?" SG (ED. It seems to me that those folks without 35mm pix are in trouble. I can speak from experience when I state that my gangs' records sky-rocketed upon using the 35mm pix. But when I judge, that model, whether it be in a 35mm or snapshot pix, has GOT to be good. So judges, dig out a magnifying glass & look over those 'smaller horses' pix. You might find they are better than the 35mm jobs. Judging is based upon your opinion, NOT photography lessons or how well a camera works, okay? Settings should help a great deal, but if the pic is overall nice, be it 35mm or snapshot, then look still first to that model. It's being judged, not the color, pic, setting, etc. Think!

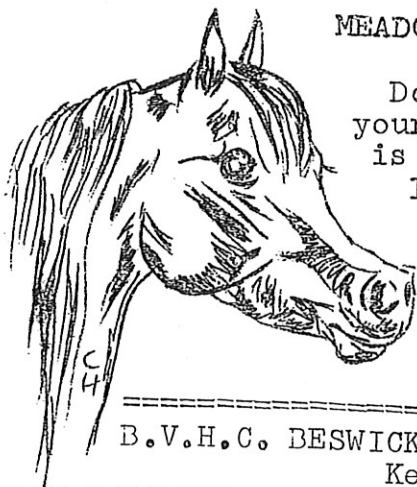

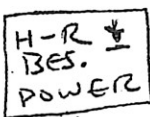

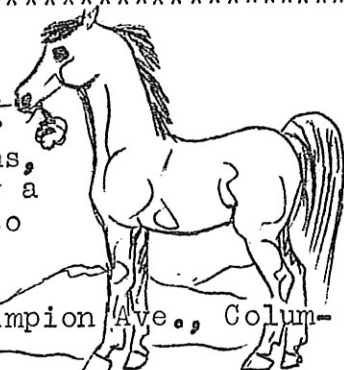

HANDY HINTS!! c/o Linda Walter, featured this time; Edith Powell

Edith has been successfully rep. her own models for some time now, and she has made a few observations. Away we go! REMOVING PAINT: Do NOT use gasoline! It takes the skin off--yours! Good paint remover is finger nail polish remover. It removes enamel & oil paints (Breyer paint, too). Acrylic paints can be taken off with denatured alcohol (water mixed with it). You must wear gloves to keep paint from getting on your fingers & hands, especially darker colors...PAINTING CERAMIC HORSES (Glazed fin.): First give the model a THIN coat of enamel paint, using short strokes. Let it be very thin, thin enough to see the orig. color. Let this dry completely & then paint as usual...PAINTBRUSH CLEANER/ENAMEL & OIL PAINT REMOVER: Turpinoïd (substitute for turpentine) is odorless but requires good ventilation. It cleans brushes real well, & it makes a good paint thinner for oil paints. Oils usually take from 3-4 days to dry & acrylics about 15 minutes (when painting) & enamels 2-3 minutes...All of these hints have been tried, but until you've practiced, you might try it out first on a model you care little for, hear? Next time, mixing enamels. Thanks, Edith

GRIPES & WHAT'S YOUR OPINION? % L. Walter

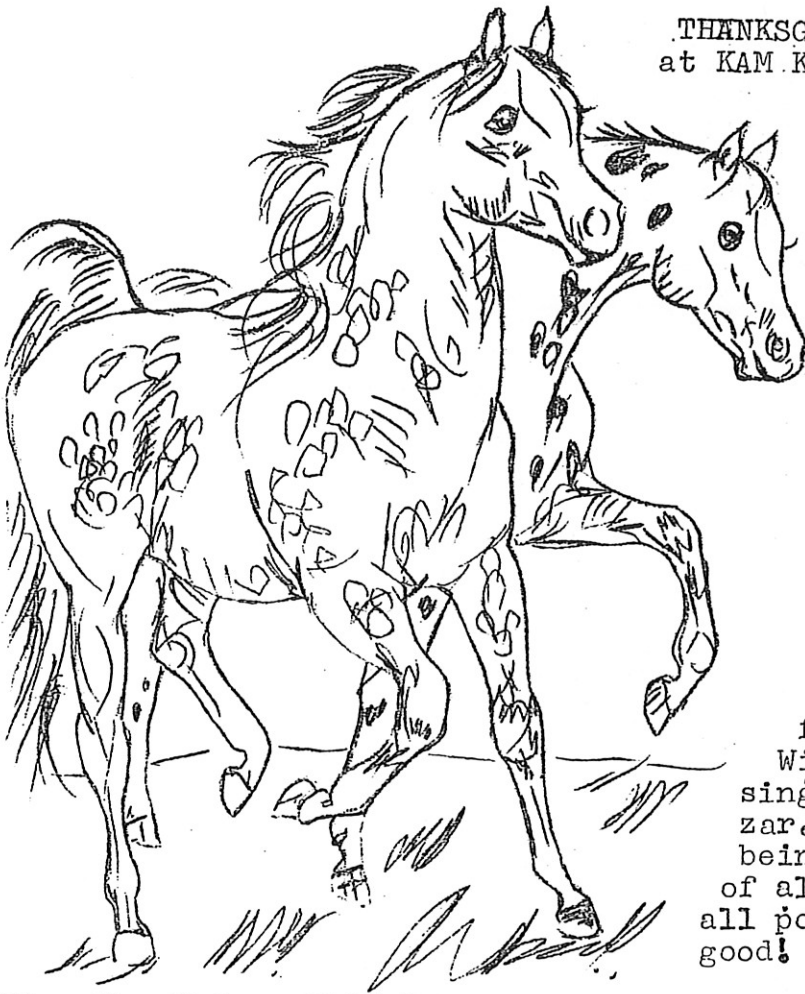
Greetings from the stampin' grounds of the ole Cackler. I am trying to catch up still on all the past goodies, so I ask you to hang in there if your GRIPE or OPINION has not yet appeared. It will, eventually. And away we go this time.

Concerning a Mini-Gripe in the Sept. MHSJ: "I don't know who said there aren't any purebred Arabs that are palomino or buckskin, but they are dead wrong! There are many beautiful palo. Arabs... As for buckskins, if the person had done their homework into colors, skin tones, they would find that Arabians have black skin, which is also characteristic of buckskins. I don't think there are many Arabians that are buckskin, but I have seen a few. I have also seen many purebred Arab Pintos, which I have been told is impossible. There are always rules made as to coloring in a certain breed, but these do not always hold true to form as in the case with mutations. I have been told ..there is no such thing as a buckskin Saddlebred, yet I own one & she is dual-regis. in both registries! ...insisted on her color being regis. as 'sandy brown' so perhaps this is where the confusion comes in. If the writer requires further proof of this, tell him/her to write me & I will send her several ads. from Arabian Horse World that should help in making another believer. I have been raising Arabs & many other breeds for several years & have learned never to say 'never' when it comes to coloring! Anything is possible." DD (ED. According to the breed registry, apparently these are the legitimate colors ONLY: bay, black, chest., grey. "White is normally assoc. w/older horses. One never sees duns, piebalds or palominos, but chestnut-speckling is fairly common on older grey horses & is referred to as 'flea-bitten'". For myself, & the MHSJ, Palo., Pinto, dun/buck. & "parti-colored" as well as roan Arabians are allowable. They DO exist, so why should they be ostracized from the others? Think about it.

"Show fees & ribbons! The former are always going up & the quality of the latter is going down. When I pay to enter a show, I usually also pay 80¢ to \$1 on postage! plus a 50¢ & over fee (though I hardly ever enter those). Then when I come home with a scrap of paper saying 1st, 2nd, 3rd crudely written on it, 'grrr'. In my shows I manage to make GOOD ribbons up to 6th with a 25¢ fee! Also a 50¢ fee with ribbons homemade only to 3rd & only 20 classes is stupid!" Name Withheld; Please. (ED. This creeps into the Gripe column more than anything else, and I tend to agree with the shower who complains. Have gotten myself a few of those weird ribbons. If you cannot give fancy ribbons, then at least make sure the horse's name, the class name/number, placing & no. in class is on it somewhere. If you cannot get the correct placing colors (1st=blue, 2nd=red, 3rd=yel., 4th=wh., 5th=pink, 6th=green), then use others but be SURE the class placing is on that ribbon. There's nothing so maddening to a shower than to get un-marked ~~rib~~, esp. poor quality ones at that. Think to yourself, 'would I be satisfied to receive THIS ribbon from a show myself?')

"I think there must be a new registry every 5th page of the MHSJ. If we support only 8-10 of them, then these registries will grow, but for every one to enter a couple of shows, own 6 models & then start a registry? We will spread ourselves so thin that no one will have a good club. If you don't like a particular rule in a club, say so, run for office but don't just start up a new club/registry. And too many times the registrant/owner loses interest. Not ALL do, but some...Think!)

NOTES OF INTEREST: The Rangerbred Horse registry is alive and well & living in Maryland! The Colo. Ranger Horse Assn., Inc., was kind enough to post me additional info on this line of spotted horses. And surprise! Color is NOT a requirement for registration. However the horse must trace authentically in unbroken descent from either of the 2 Foundation Sires, Patches #1 or Max #2. Outcrosses are acceptable but must be from approved & regis. parent(s). Like the Appaloosa, draft/pony blood in ineligible. I was interested to learn their ancestors were an Arabian, a Barb & native Mustang types. When the ranger has color, it is described the same as in Appaloosas, such as raindrop, snow-flaked, blanket-hipped, etc. The 1970 High Point Perf. Horse at the 23rd Natl. App Show was Mighty High, a duo-regis. Colo. Rangerbred-Appaloosa mare. She went on to become World's Champion App Perf. Horse. So a spotted horse by any other name, just might be a Rangerbred. Long live those spots!

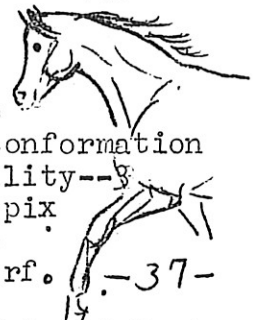
