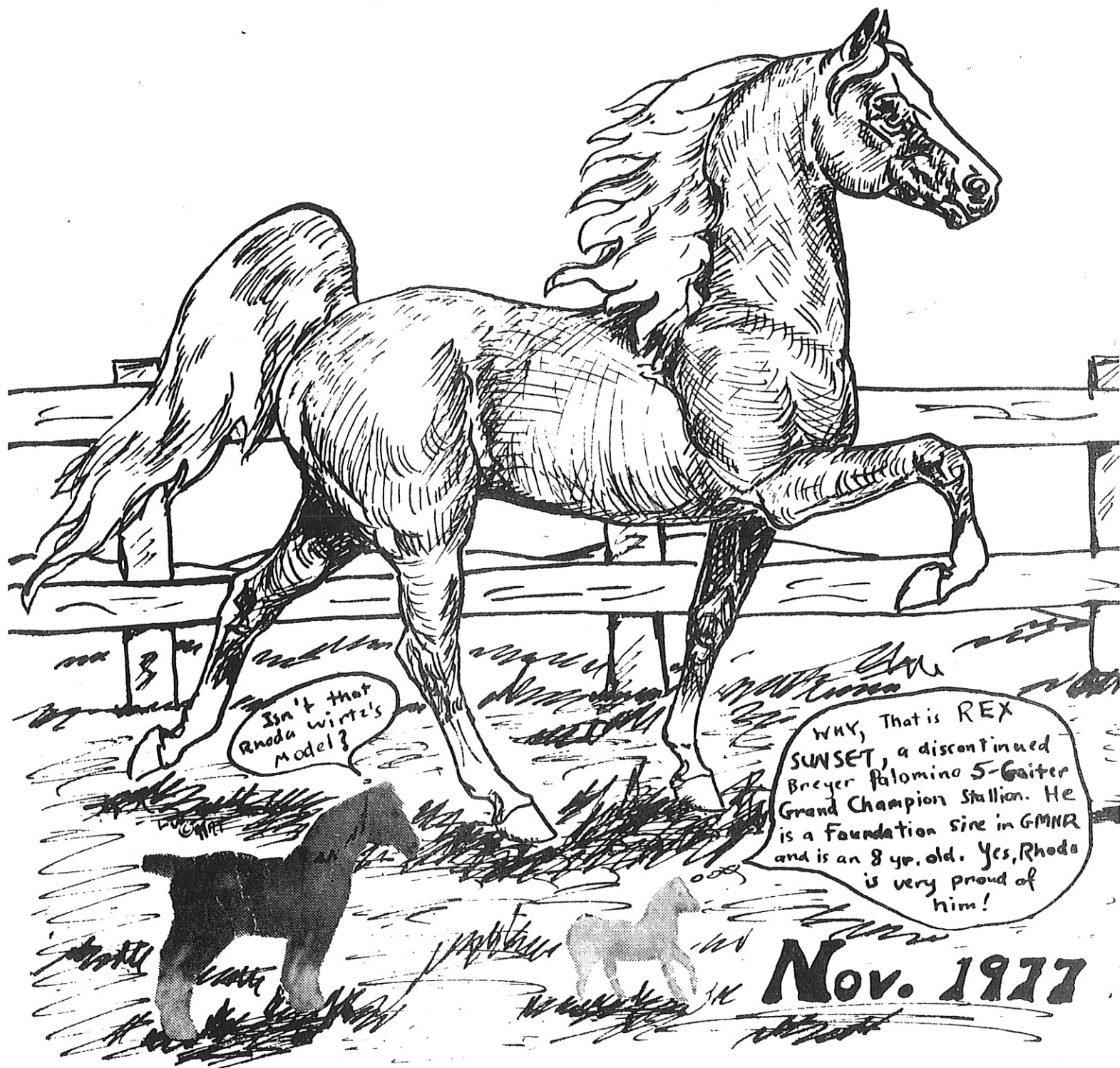

NEW SHOWERS'S ONLY SHOW: Pix quality overall was pretty good! There was a really good mixture of 35mm & instamatic shots as well as a sprinkling of Polaroids & others. I was further amazed at the quality of the tack on many models, mostly homemade, and very realistic. Nice going!...Postage: This was the major goof. Very few people sent enough, or they sent stamps which had been used before. This is no good. Also if you put tape over the stamps so they cannot be cancelled, the post office is not supposed to honor them, thus they go out postage due or are returned for correct postage. So please watch those stamps. Several did not take advantage of the slight discount the post office gives you after the 1st ounce of 13¢ weight, being 11¢ each additional ounce. True, 11¢ stamps may be difficult for you to buy or get to the post office for, but in the long run that 2¢-10¢ you save EACH time adds up...Some ribbons awarded were not like the regular show ribbons, & this is because they were from my own winnings. Rather than send back, and disappoint many, very few ribbons to a person, I held a 'mini-show' giving comm. ribbons again. That way all got, hopefully, at least 3 awards/ribbons...Champs/Res. were decided on points & ties were usually broken by looking once more very hard at the entries...Entry fees: We broke even again on the show, thank you! Some of the fees were refunded in part since they were overpaid...Duplicate horses: Had 2 people enter the same horse, under the same name, in the same pix. Since I didn't know who actually owned the horse or who had the show rights, this fine model was disqualified. I'm sorry! But please, show model sellers, how about selling the horse & its showrights just to 1 person--not 2? That is, the model to 1 & showrights to another. This leads possibly to the same situation as above. Thanks..Again to all who entered my deepest thanks--and older showers, watch out, they are going to get 'us', ha. Take care, see you new people next year in the show. LLW

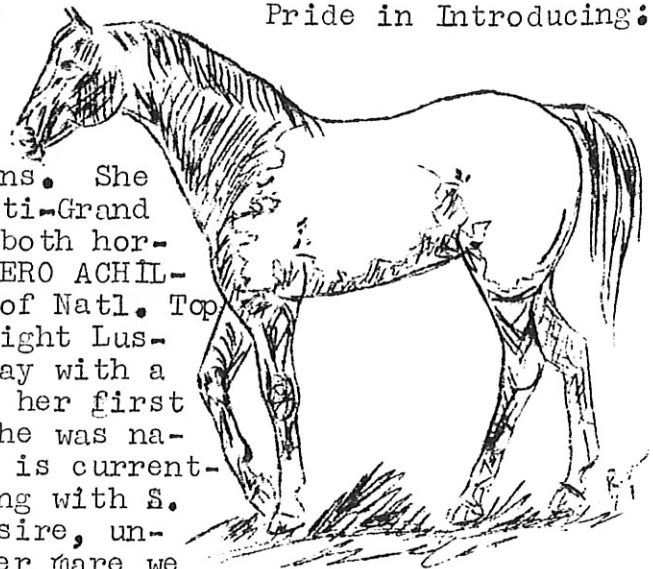

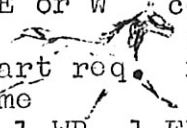

few years had been selling in places for upwards of \$8.95. From 1974 on

he was produced only in the doeskin/light grey color w/dk. points. Price

ranges on the older rosey greys & whites can run from \$15 to \$35 & more

depending on condition, age & eye detail. The older the model, the more

eye colors used. Such as the oldest usually have tri-color eyes of black

pupil, brown outer ring & white in corners, sometimes w/black eyeliner
